

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Model 736B probe is designed as both a general duty and a heavy duty probe - each with a Teflon faced flange. Various flange sizes and pressure ratings are standard options that are readily available.

Flanges are available in either carbon steel or 316 stainless steel. Each gland is welded to the flange selected prior to assembly of the probe.

The general duty probe utilizes a 7/32" stainless steel rod with 3/8" O.D. Teflon insulation. The heavy duty probe utilizes a 15/32" stainless steel rod with 3/4" O.D. Teflon insulation. Each probe is of rigid type construction.

Other features available on the Robertshaw Model 736B probe are:

- Factory bent probes for special uses.
- Ground wire probes for use where a ground to the liquid product is hard to obtain.
- Probes with a Teflon insulated sheath which makes the sheathed portion of the probe inactive.





Bent Probe Option




For insulated sheath option, sheath must terminate 2" or more before start of bend.

- Flange is Welded to Probe Gland




